

## **Policy 3-10: Use of University and College Equipment**

### **1. Shop Resources**

The equipment and resources of the college shop are reserved for academic purposes, only. The term “academic purposes” is broadly defined to include activities that are reasonably related to the teaching, research, and service functions of the college. Initial responsibility for compliance with this policy is with the individual user. The shop director shall have authority to prohibit the use of shop resources on a case-by-case basis when it appears they are being used for substantially non-academic purposes. Disagreements on the interpretation of this policy will be resolved by the dean.

### **2. Computing Resources**

Use of college and university computing resources is governed by [University Rule 4-004A](#). The use of college and university email is further limited by Utah Code 20A-11-1205, which states that “a person may not send an email using the email of a public entity, for a political purpose or to advocate for or against a ballot proposition.”
