

Policy 1-07: Academic Assessment

The CA+P requires that all academic programs be assessed systematically and that courses and programs be updated based on data obtained through formal assessment. Courses, programs, degrees, majors, minors, concentrations, emphases, certificates, graduate programs, interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary programs, and other groups of courses must be assessed.

Documentation of systematic assessment and course and program improvement is to be maintained. Reports are to be regularly submitted as determined by the dean and/or department chair. Refer to the *CA+P Academic Assessment Manual* for further information.
