

Policy 4-16: Bicycle Parking

The intent of this policy is to provide support for members of our community who choose to bicycle. Bicycling supports environmental sustainability and enhances personal physical and emotional health. Facilitating secure temporary storage of bicycles is important for encouraging their use. Although the use of outdoor bicycle racks is adequate for many, many others desire more security.

The preferred option for secure bicycle parking is one of the bicycle cages located either side of the westside 1st floor entry to the BUC building, just east of the Architecture Building. These cages are secured by card access, meaning that only persons who register with the University Commuter Services Office have access. For information, look at the sign on the outside of the cages or call 801-581-6415.

Those who prefer to bring their bikes into the Architecture Building or the Field House must observe the following standards:

Life safety egress must be maintained. This means at least 44 inches of clear space in all primary corridors and no bicycles in the stairwells or near building entrances.

Basic cleanliness of the building must also be maintained. That means no bikes are allowed in the building that are muddy or dripping or otherwise likely to create a mess.
